Budget

The cost of this project would be a small percentage of the budget. Remember, the current cost of homelessness is in the billions that could be avoided. Initial costs would be 10-15 million, in which case we are looking for synergies and donations to control costs. Countries can be shared and great discounts can be availed. In addition, we plan to use convention style tents in our facilities, including individual lockers. This strategy would ensure rapid construction and keep costs low.

Later, permanent structures can be built after costs have stabilized. The structure is simple, low cost and efficient. It is hoped that the National Guard will offer its expertise and assistance in the construction and planning of the ranch. The costs mentioned in this report are preliminary. If this conceptual approach is approved for voting, a cost study project will be created to evaluate the results needed to accomplish this task.

Funding Sources

Currently, the largest part of the state's expenses is the budget for the renewal of highways and roads. Streets will be updated as needed. Roads that do not need rehabilitation are currently a waste of government spending. Solution: Put in road repairs if needed and use the savings to build the ranch. In addition, federal funding can cover shortfalls or supplemental funding.
